Esteemed Mr. Füle,

**IN EUROPEAN UNION WITH THE BOLSHEVIK LUGGAGE**

Croatia, actually Republic of Croatia, is preparing to enter European Union. Years have passed. Negotiations are continuously conducting, as is

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usually said, "With Europe." Chapter by chapter. Regulations have been changed. The social system is being adjusted.

Nothing special, or worrying. As can be told. But, only at the first sight.

However, all that is done **behind the back of Croatian citizens**. Bolshevik way. We do not know specifically with whom they negotiate, with which persons (and at which address). We do not know what specifically is negotiated about and what is requested from the Croatia. Above all, **we didn't have the opportunity to give any suggestions, express our opinion and to point out the changes that we also seek.**

We are surprised that it is tolerated by the European Union.

Obviously, we will be deceived. Like "geese in the fog".

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Next in line is the Chapter 23. We can read ([www.tportal.hr](http://www.tportal.hr) - May 25, 2010.):

*"The draft of joint negotiating position is referred to the Council of EU, as been told in the office of Stefan Füle. Commissioner Füle said, early last week, before members of committee of the European Parliament for foreign affairs that 'progress in cooperation with the ICTY will be crucial in persuading member states to open this chapter'."*

And?

Yugoslav Bolshevik leader Josip Broz Tito, which "traces stink of inhumanity", author of - on laws and civilized norms - insubstantial murders and persecution of hundreds of thousands of Croatians (certainly

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and members of other nationalities who lived in Yugoslavia) used to say to the judges: **"We should not keep the law as drunk man keeps the fence"**.

To say, in bolshevik practice which he implemented, meant to command. Without complaint. Said meant done. Ruthlessly carried out. For "make-up" that was transferred to "rubber laws". Laws that could apply to anyone, at any time. Of course, completely unfounded and without any relation to actual facts and evidence.

Republic of Croatia "inherited" those laws. Nothing strange when it is well known that the government in Croatia is still under (through the Croatian Democratic Union and Social Democratic Party - the renamed Communist Party of Croatia) disguised Bolshevik chiefs.

These are primarily the article 292<sup>nd</sup> and 337<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with the article 37<sup>th</sup> of the Criminal Code of Croatia, the concerned **"incitement on abuse in business operations."** As a rule, without any evidence. Only suspicion is sufficient (actually the command of members of secret political bureau, whose members really "clears and clouds" Croatia).

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It is not a secret that the same objectives are attempted now with entering Croatian republic into the European Union. They say, the same ones who were the pillars of the Yugo-Bolshevism, bluntly: We're going to the EU, but in our way, with our people, with our views and our practice. Bolshevik way.

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"Therefore, lately in the working group for amending of the Criminal Code very hard and very lively discussions are done, sometimes on the border of dispute.

'Changing the criminal law relating to economic crime is **necessary to remove the remains of the socialist legal system** and to coordinate our legislation with the legal achievements of the European Union and the legislation of a modern European states' - says dr. Peter Novoselec, a member of the working group for amending Criminal Code.

Speaking in a rough outline of what is wrong in law that we have (because there are no solutions that the workgroup could accept and all suggestions are open for suggestions), dr. Novoselec says that our **businessmen are equalized with government officials**, and offenses against the market competition (so-called Cartel Criminal Law) are not compatible with the legal achievements of the European Union, but is not compatible even with the Croatian Law About Protection of Economic Competition. "

But, But, but, but ...

"Specifically, whole chapter of the Criminal Code should be modernized, in which the Economic Crime is described. It means that some acts should be deleted and new ones should be defined. All that must be done, so there **must be continuity between the old and new.**"

Continuity! **New which is old, in fact?** Theirs continuity! Bolshevik! Despite the European Parliament resolutions.

Dear European gentlemen, we want to say gently, **we are not joining the European Union**, if it means that, as with slaves, Jugo-Bolshevik committee members are going to command any further. Although, if you send tanks on us. After all, you'll see!

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### Personal addendum

So was I sentenced to four-year prison sentence, followed by "rubber

articles" - article number 292<sup>nd</sup> and 337<sup>th</sup> in the connection with article 37<sup>th</sup> of the Penal Code of the Republic of Croatia and by the verdict of the County Court in Slavonski Brod, ? K-32/04-137 from January 8, 2009, which was confirmed by the verdict of the Supreme Court ? I Kz 282/09-6 from December 23, 2009, although:

a) **there is not a single evidence** that could confirm that I've **encouraged** Mirjana Marinoviæ, the director of the company "Brodvin" Joint Stock Company from Slavonski Brod, to commit the crime, nor I've had any reason for that,

b) what is "crime act": the acquisition of illegal profit in the form of realizing the price difference in the purchase-sale of shares and business stakes. That is **not a criminal offense** according to the Criminal Code of the Republic of Croatia, or by any other legal legislation of Croatia, or by the international law,

c) where I was **prevented from using** the witnesses and expert witnesses of court.

Also, for the same "crime" my wife was convicted. My companies in Zagreb: "Dragunov ured" Ltd., "Prisika" Ltd. and "Financijska revizija Dragun" Ltd. were convicted, but **they have not even been charged, nor they have been invited to the Court** during the underlying trial court proceedings, **nor their business records has been examined** from which is clearly visible what they did and how they have worked, and whether they actually violated the law.

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Regarding this, **but not only this**, me and my wife, *have asked for the political asylum* in the Republic of Slovenia (European Union), and I'm submitting my book "*Vesna Vrbetiæ, the judge, That's how the justice is carried out - The First Book*" for review.

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I'm expecting your, appropriate and on-time response.
